

LOCAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM DETAILS AND APPLICATION

As a benefit for chapter service, Greater Denver Chapter No. 17 encourages its CPM[®] Candidate and Associate members to complete their education and obtain the CPM[®] Designation, attend IREM National Conference, and for students to attend events. It is recognized that IREM[®] Courses require a time and financial commitment, which may be difficult for some members to satisfy. For that reason, IREM[®] Greater Denver Chapter No. 17 periodically makes funds available to assist in completing a portion of the required education. The Chapter scholarships are in honor of *R. Louise Dutton, CPM[®] Emeritus*.

R. Louise Dutton, CPM[®] Emeritus Scholarship Requirements

To be considered for this local chapter scholarship, the applicant must:

- Complete and submit the attached application form
- Be member of Greater Denver Chapter No. 17 in good standing

R. Louise Dutton, CPM[®] Emeritus Scholarship Terms and Considerations:

- Scholarships may be awarded for any course sponsored by IREM[®]
 - On-Line and Home Study courses
 - Classroom courses out of state
 - Classroom courses hosted by the Greater Denver Chapter
 - Scholarship awards can be up to 100% of the course fee, based on funds availability
- Scholarships may be awarded to members wishing to attend an IREM[®] National Conference.
- Scholarships may be awarded to student members to subsidize costs for attending events.
- Scholarships are not limited.
- Scholarships may be awarded to the same individual multiple times during a single year
 - Previous denial does not imply future denial; previous award does not imply future award
- In the event application requests exceed funding capability, the Executive Council will review the applications and make final award decisions based on:
 - Previous award history
 - Chapter engagement
 - Courses completed at time of application
- This policy can be amended at any time by the Executive Council. Exceptions to this policy can be made at the discretion of the Executive Council. The Scholarship policy can be found at <https://iremdenver.org/page-18071>
